CERT

- Community Emergency Response Team (also Training)
- Origin: LAFD mid 80's
- FEMA made the program available nationwide in the early 90's
- Provide critical assistance when professional responders are not immediately available to help



CERT Basic Training

- Fire Extinguisher/ Fire Safety
- Disaster First Aid/ Triage (RPM)
- Mass Casualty Operations
- Light SAR
- Lifts and Carries
- Damage Assessment
- Haz Mat Awareness
- Disaster Psychology
- NIMS & ICS
- Basic Radio Procedures
- CPR/AED





CERT Members Roles

 Critical assistance during emergencies.

 Emergency preparedness programs.





CERTS Can work in:

- Evacuations
- Neighborhood Windshield Surveys or On Foot Damage Assessment.
- Light SAR
- Triage and Rapid Trauma Assessment
- Basic Life Support.
- Shelter Ops
- Crowd Control





CERT Training

- Three sessions every year. (whenever possible)
- Program follows FEMA approved curriculum.
- It includes CPR/AED.
- Participants receive a basic CERT kit.
- Open to all County residents.








NEW! STORM CAMP
