## steps to obtain an FCC amateur radio license

- register to take a Technician test at a test session today
  - ARRL Find an Amateur Radio License Exam Session
  - <u>Laurel VEC Exam Schedule</u> free
  - HAMSTUDY Upcoming in-person sessions
  - <u>Baltimore VE Team</u>, Baltimore, MD area
  - MARC/Laurel VE Team, Rockville, MD area
    - class test session May 1, 2022 at 8:30 AM
    - register at <u>education@marcclub.org</u>

## steps to obtain an FCC amateur radio license

- obtain an FCC Registration Number (FRN) <u>instructions</u>
  - REGISTER an FCC Username Login
    - use a personal email address
  - LOG IN and REGISTER NEW FRN
    - can obtain multiple FRNs for family members
    - you are an individual
    - disclose your SSN only once to the FCC
    - use personal email address

## steps to obtain an FCC amateur radio license

- fill out an <u>interactive NCVEC Form 605</u>
  - use any valid US postal address
  - use personal email address
  - save as a PDF file signature at test session
  - we require your FRN and do not accept your SSN
  - we do not accept a scanned copy
- pass the Technician test
- pay the \$35 application fee directly to the FCC starting April 19, 2022
  - email from the FCC with a link with payment instructions
  - pay within 10 calendar days
  - second email from the FCC with a link to your official license
