

The Montgomery Amateur Radio Club Net Script

As of May 2025

=====

→ Good evening, it is 7:30 and time to begin the regular weekly net on the 146.955 repeater sponsored by MARC, the Montgomery Amateur Radio Club.

=====

→ The net control station for this evening's net is
[>>Your Call-sign Phonetically<<], [>>Your Call-sign<<]
and my name is [>>Your Name<<].

=====

→ This is a directed net which means all communications between stations should be directed through the net control station.

=====

→ This net is a regularly scheduled MARC event which begins at 7:30 every Sunday evening to provide members and guests an opportunity to hear about past and future club activities, and other items of interest related to amateur radio.

→ All Amateur Radio Operators are welcome to participate.

=====

→ This weekly net operates in conjunction with MARC's two monthly meetings which are held on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month.

→ Meetings begin at 7:30 p.m. and are currently held on Zoom.

→ For specific meeting information, please visit the "Club Meetings" section found on the Montgomery Amateur Radio Club's website.

→ I will now begin taking check-ins. When you check-in, please say your call-sign slowly using standard phonetics and include your name.

→ I will now ask for any club officers who would like to check-in, please call net control now, this is [>>Your Call-sign<<]. [Acknowledge check-ins]

→ I will now ask for any stations with announcements or information for the net, please say your call-sign only
[Acknowledge check-ins. Ask for their announcements now or later.]

=====

→ I will now begin taking general check-ins.

Again, please say your call-sign slowly using standard phonetics and include your name.

[Stagger Call-Sign check-ins to your Liking]

→ Do we have any stations with a call-sign that begins with the letter Alpha (A) who would like to check-in, please call now.

[Acknowledge check-ins]

→ Any stations with a call-sign that begins with the letter Kilo (K) who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

→ Any stations with a call-sign that begins with the letter November (N) who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

→ Any stations with a call-sign that begins with the letter Whiskey (W) who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

→ Any stations with call-signs not previously acknowledged, who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

>OR<

→ Do we have any stations with the call-sign suffix Alpha through Lima, A through L, the suffix is the letter immediately following the number in your call-sign, who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

→ Do we have any stations with the call-sign suffix Mike through Zulu, M through Z, again the suffix is the letter immediately following the number in your call-sign, those who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

→ Any stations not previously acknowledged who would like to check-in, please call now. **[Acknowledge check-ins]**

[If Newsline available, ask for comments before or after Newsline]

[Otherwise ask for comments]

→ I will now go through the list of stations who checked in, and give everyone who has comments the opportunity to make comments for the net.

>OR<

→ Please call the station with Amateur Radio Newsline.

=====
→ I will now call for any last minute check-ins not previously acknowledged, please call net control now, this is **[>>Your Call-sign<<]** **[Acknowledge check-ins, ask for any comments]**

=====

→ There were **[++Total Number of Check-ins++]** stations that checked-in plus Net Control to tonight's net and everyone is thanked for their participation.

=====

→ MARC looks forward to seeing you at its monthly meetings and hearing you on this weekly net.

=====

- This is **[>>Your Call-sign<<]** closing the net and returning the KV3B MARC repeater to regular amateur use.
